Parking Regulations

Adopted September 8, 2020

Revised August 3, 2021

Marion parking regulations vary by location and time of the year.

1. Areas requiring privilege stickers at all times, overnight (10PM to 6AM) parking *is not* permitted: (direct abutters are permitted overnight with permission of BOS)

- Planting Island Cove Access road
- Wing's Cove boat ramp and parking area (Rochester residents require additional privilege sticker)
- Silvershell Beach Parking area
- Planting Island Causeway parking areas
- DePina Beach Parking area
- Oakdale Avenue beach area

2. Areas and streets requiring privilege stickers for overnight parking are listed below. It should be noted that in locations that permit overnight parking, this *does not* permit overnight occupancy of the vehicle:

- Island Wharf
- Front Street (South of Route 6)
- Cottage Street
- Hiller Street
- Main Street (Spring Street to Water Street)
- South Street
- Pleasant Street (South Street to Pitcher Street)
- Water Street
- Old Landing Wharf parking area

3. The following are designated "Tow-Away Zones" in Marion:

- All of Front Street South of Route 6
- Old Landing Wharf parking areas
- All of Ryder's Lane
- Island Wharf and Island Wharf parking areas

- Main Street between Front and Water Streets
- South Street between Front and Water Streets
- Water Street, both sides, between Main and South Streets
- Silvershell Beach parking area
- Wing's Cove boat ramp and parking area
- Planting Island Causeway parking areas
- All driveway openings

4. Boat trailers *are not* permitted to park on any street in Marion. Boat trailers may be parked in the following designated areas:

- Island Wharf – privilege sticker is required for parking up to 72 hours
- Wing's Cove launching ramp – privilege sticker required (Rochester residents require additional privilege sticker)
- Benson Brook Road outside of the gate. Park wheel to road, facing Route 6
- Old Landing Wharf – non-resident business, water-related services towing vehicle parking only. See Old Landing Launching Regulations adopted 6/20/00
- For specific events, the Harbormaster may identify additional locations applicable to that specific event
