

TOWN OF MARION DINGHY RACK REGULATIONS

1. Fee: \$50.00 per Dinghy Rack. A Non-Resident Privilege Permit fee of \$ 100.00 applies to each rack occupied by a non-resident/non taxpayer. (See Town of Marion Waterways Regulations)
2. Size of dinghies allowed: maximum length ten (10) feet - maximum beam five (5) feet
3. All boats must be secured with chain or cable and locks.
4. The Town of Marion is not liable for any loss of, or damage to, any boat occupying a rack space.
5. Boats must be stored in the numbered space assigned to the renter.
6. Boats may not be left on the ground and secured to the dinghy racks.
7. Rack spaces are rented on an annual basis and may be renewed by the occupant. Renewal forms will be mailed to the renter by April 1st of each year. **Payment is due by May 15th of each year. A late charge of \$100.00 will be assessed if the dinghy rack fee is not received by May 15th. Failure to pay the fee and the late charge by May 30th will result in the cancellation of your dinghy rack. Please pay promptly.**
8. Vacant spaces will be available to residents only through June 15th. After June 15th, vacancies will be filled by the applicants at the top of the Waiting List. **Refusal of an offer for a dinghy rack space may result in the removal of your name from the Waiting List.** Applicants do not have to be Marion residents **but all applicants must be at least 18 years old.**
9. Occupancy of dinghy rack spaces by a non-resident is limited to 1/3 (one third) of the total spaces at each location (example -- 1/3 of the spaces at Old Landing -- 1/3 of the spaces at Island Wharf ~ Wings Cove).
10. The permit for any space not occupied by July 1st will be rescinded and awarded to the next applicant.
11. An applicant who has not paid his/her mooring permit fee, privilege permit fee, or marine excise tax is not eligible to rent a dinghy rack space.
12. One rack only per household. With permission of the Harbormaster, a rack may be used temporarily, not exceeding 14 days (cumulative), by a family member, but the rack holder may not rent out the rack.
13. Any violation of these Regulations may result in the removal of the boat in question at the owner's expense and cancellation of the space assignment. In the event of such a cancellation, fees will not be refunded.
14. Boat may be put in place any time after May 15 and must be removed by November 1. Any boats not removed will be removed by the Harbormasters office and a \$25.00 handling fee will be charged to the rack holder. In case of a HURRICANE WATCH, you must remove your boat or the handling fee will be charged.
